- 2. Each participant shall list the geometric imperfections on each picture in accordance with the EN ISO 6520-1 (2007) and EN ISO 6520-2 (2013).
- 3. Observations shall be performed respecting the following conditions:
 - One operator only
- 4. The following information is to be reported:
 - Classification of imperfection

- 1 Crack
- 2 Cavity/Porosity
- 3 Inclusions
- 4 Lack of fusion and penetration
- 5 Incomplete root penetration
- 6 Undercut
- 7 Excess weld metal
- 8 Misalignment
- 9 Spatter
- 10 Incorrect root gap for fillet welds
- 11 Miscellaneous imperfections
- 12 Other (indicate)
